Kodiak Push to Talk – Instant Calling



Kodiak Push to Talk (PTT) is a half-duplex, instant calling voice application that allows users to call individuals and groups at the press of a button. Leveraging the quality of service (QoS) already available on existing wireless voice networks, Kodiak PTT calls have the fastest call set-up time and lowest voice latency in the industry. Kodiak PTT addresses the diverse communications requirements of business organizations, service professionals and consumers, by offering a commercially-proven, premium voice application recognized worldwide for its superior performance.

FEATURE OVERVIEW

- Kodiak PTT callers can make instant calls to individual contacts and groups in the PTT phonebook at the touch of a button
- Users can make group calls to a pre-determined group of individuals or utilize the Quick Group feature to create one-time, ‘ad-hoc’ groups
- Subscribers can send an on-screen “Call me alert” to another PTT user to request an instant or mobile voice conversation
- Once a PTT session is established, the originator can convert an instant group call to a full-duplex conference call
- The Call Waiting feature is also supported with PTT, so users are notified of incoming calls and able to accept, decline or swap calls

Time-Saving – Kodiak PTT Presence Manager indicates whether users are available for instant calls

Fast and Efficient – Kodiak PTT enables instant communications with both individuals and groups; calls can be set-up in as little as 2-3 seconds

Flexible – Users can begin a PTT session and then convert to a full-duplex conference call if the nature of the conversation changes

Convenient – Users can easily select PTT contacts and groups from their PTT contact list

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Users can easily manage their presence status and instantly communicate their availability to receive PTT calls.

Subscribers can navigate Kodiak PTT-enabled mobile applications through a common and simple graphical user interface.

Users can instantly create, modify and delete individual contacts, groups, and group members, directly on their handsets.

Contact information is permission-based and able to be shared between Kodiak PTT subscribers.

Contact information is permanently saved on the operator network and can be easily restored in the event of a new, lost or stolen handset.



THE KODIAK CONNECTED DIFFERENCE FOR WIRELESS OPERATORS

Roaming Support – Enables the initiation or receipt of calls outside the operator's home network in expanded coverage areas provided by roaming partners. This capability greatly extends the PTT service reach of CDMA and GSM operators.

Lawful Intercept/CALEA Compliance – The Kodiak RTX System is compliant with the existing standards for call intercept by law enforcement agencies.

Priority Calling Support – When implemented by the wireless operator, Kodiak supports the latest Wireless Priority Service (WPS) industry requirements for GSM-based systems. This feature offers first responders, law enforcement, and emergency personnel the option of priority channel override in the event of system congestion.
